This had the miraculous effect in that it freed up a great deal of my evening time to draw cartoons. I decided to draw at least one cartoon every day. Sometimes I draw more. It is really helping me get back into the swing of serious cartooning.

Thank you to all who gave me birthday gifts! While not as popular as the Etoonin' Appeal of 2008, many people gave me grocery store gift cards. I ate for all of March for free. I am very grateful. Things are still extremely tight financially over here. I am 3 mortgage payments behind and have begun negotiations with the bank to see if the federal bailout applies to me too. I met with a credit counselor and she seemed to suggest things are hopeful for me to retain my home. The Good Sense Financial Class at Grace Chapel was very helpful as well. It was very encouraging. However, I will probably forget most of it. So I plan to take it again at the next location it is offered. I am hoping David Andrews will offer to be my financial counselor next. Maybe if I bake him brownies. Budget deficits led me to switch from private to state subsidized health care. I hope this will continue to cover all my health care needs. As you might suspect, bipolar disorder can be an expensive illness to have. I am taking a step of faith that my new job, although completely commission based, will eventually earn me the extra income I need to balance my budget and start moving toward financial freedom. I remain committed to trying to follow what the Lord has for me to do each day. I trust in the Lord.

Anyway, it has been really helpful to have gift cards so that I don't need to worry about eating, even if I have other financial problems.
