It can be painful to release yourself to this kind of love, for we are so used to covering our sin. We are used to protecting ourselves. Freedom in God means freedom from fear, and He gives freedom in this life. We can do anything in Him, satisfying even our deepest desires. We can even be what we were meant to be, free from a mediocre life.
