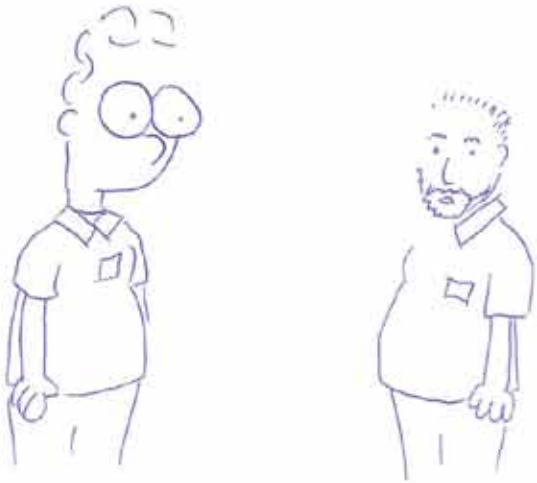

Raz is useless.

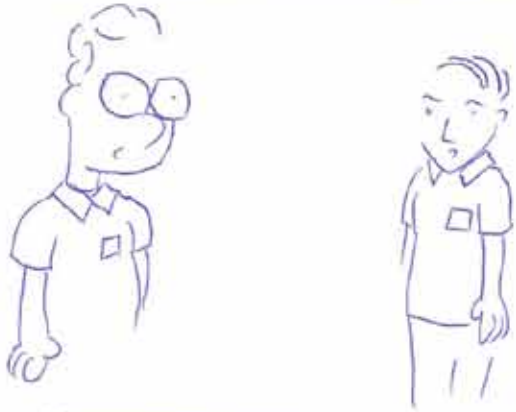

Just think about how you bought your car for \$1200.

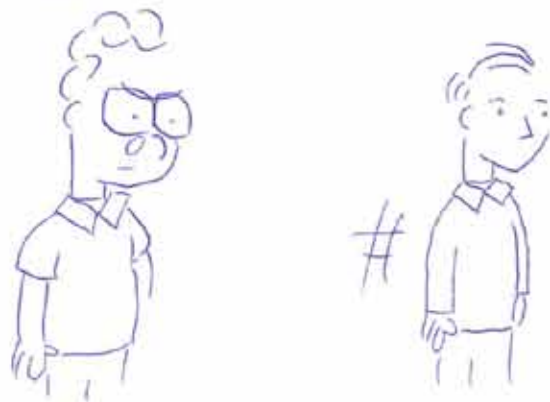


In a year, if we make the million dollar challenge, you can buy another car.

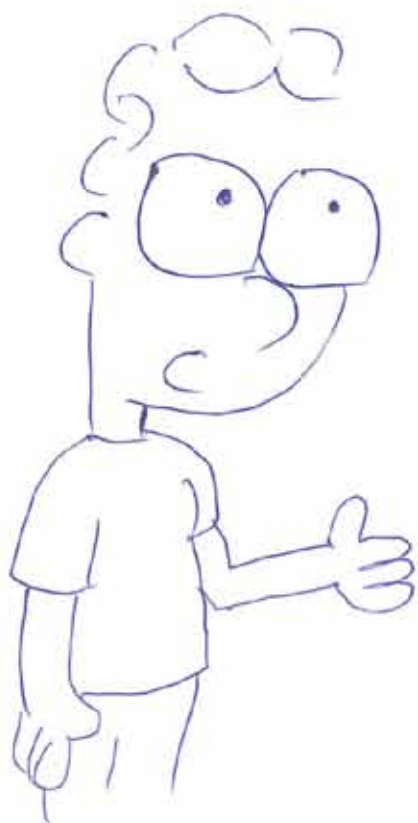
