


The You Had Me At Hotel Idea







I also completed two short term projects to gain exposure. I find it easy to do the work because I remember the CAD software (Creo + AutoCAD) from 13 years ago. My boss is even keel and I've enjoyed reconnecting with old friends and colleagues. Projects keep me engaged with other engineers who feed me my work, so I don't deal directly with my boss. I can "work from home" and I get every other Friday off with the 9/80 Schedule. My summer vacations are already approved (Puerto Rico and Sacramento, CA). Raytoonin' contributes 7% to my 401k and I contribute 10%. I'm already vested. There is also a Bible Study on Wednesdays that I attend. I am the 1% that got off SSDI and Section 8 housing!
