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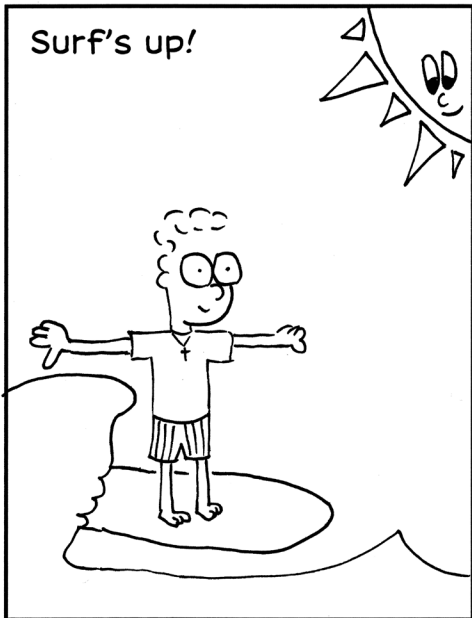


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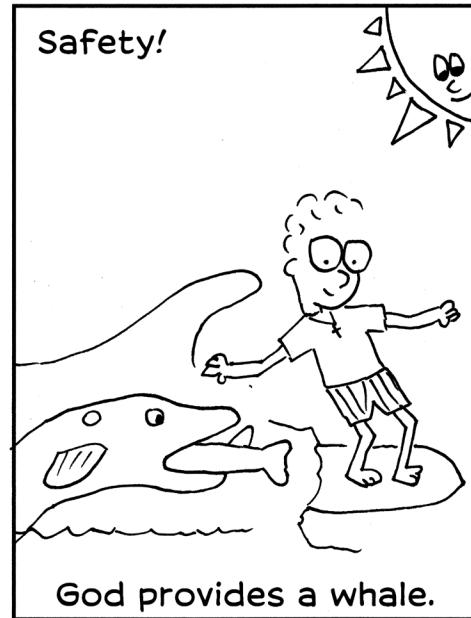


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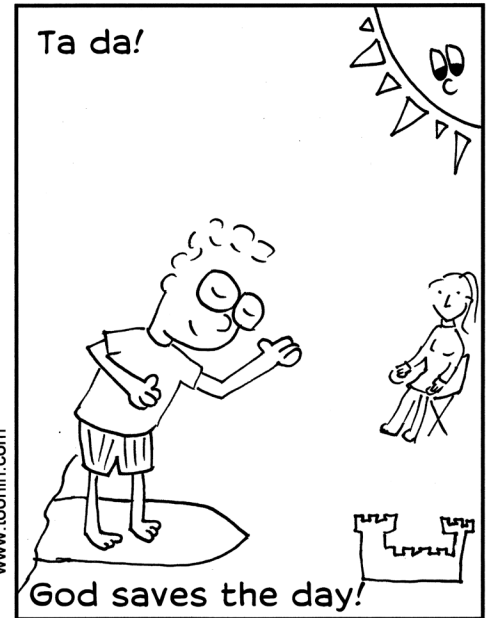
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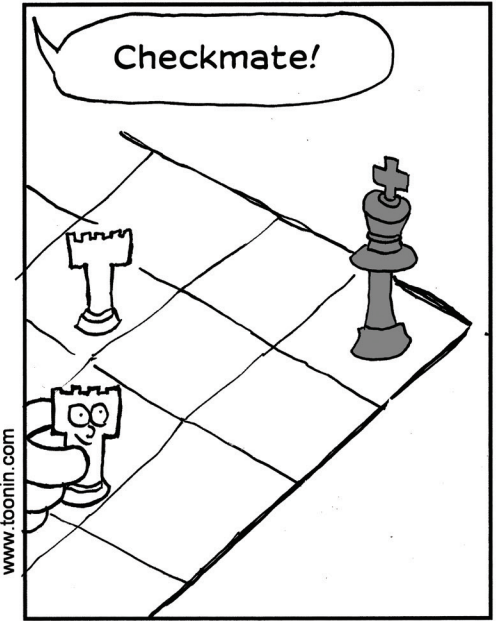
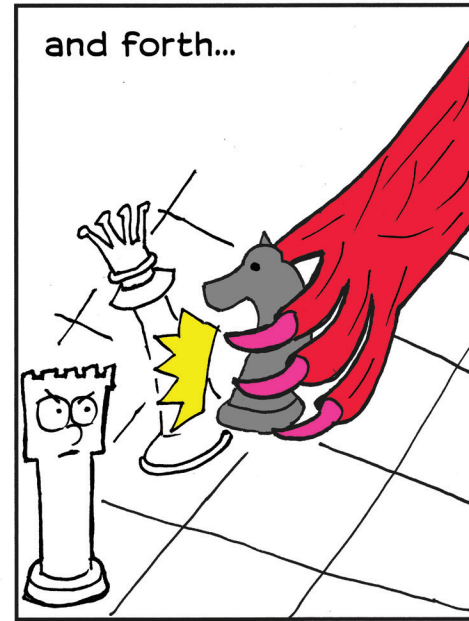
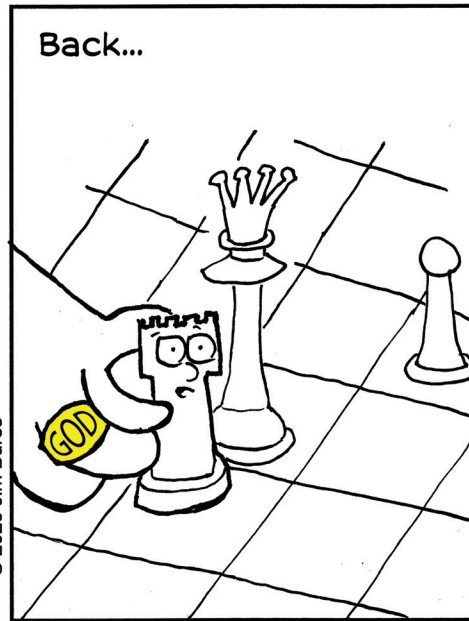


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"I don't want to work, I just want to bang on the drum all day."
